

To improve the **energy performance** of the partner regions thanks to improved **smart grid policies** to manage energy demand and consumption

- → Focus on 3 main areas of work:
 - Consumers' acceptance
 - Economic models
 - Funding sources





A 2-phase project

<u>Phase 1</u>: Exchange of good practices and definition of an action plan (3 years)

- Analysis of local energy conditions
- Interregional exchange of good practices (GP)
- Definition of a regional action plan (AP)

Phase 2 : Implementation and monitoring of the action plan (2 years)

- Markets that work for flexibility


Clean Growth Strategy, October 2017



What is Green BELLE?

Grants to SMEs for low carbon and energy efficient measures

- European Regional Development Fund project
- Leicester Energy Agency (Leicester City Council)
- 3 year project September 2019









Green BELLE Aims to...

- Helping local businesses
- Improve premises
- Reduce energy use
- Support the local low carbon economy







So far, Green BELLE has helped over 148 36









Green BELLE Grants

- £1,000 £10,000 grant
- Energy efficient measures
- 50% grant, 50% SME match funding

or

2 days non-financial support







Eligibility Criteria

- Small to Medium-Sized Enterprises (SMEs)
- Located in Leicester or Leicestershire
- Retail is now supported!
- Certain business sector restrictions apply, e.g. banking, insurance and social welfare facilities.

Case Study – Sapcote Engineering Limited

 Engineering company - Broughton Astley

BELLE

- Measures applied for: LED high bay lighting, new gas blowers and destratification fans
- Green BELLE grant of £6,521.78
- Energy savings of 61%, 20% and 20%
- Already installed; LED lighting and solar $P\overline{V}$











Case Study

+

- Medical supply business in Leicester
- Already had efficient lighting, heating, insulation and windows, and solar panels
- Measures applied for: battery storage for solar PV
- Green BELLE grant of £10,000
- Could save up to £1,800 per year on electricity bills











- Recruitment consultancy business North West Leicestershire
- Measures applied for: Solar PV and LED Lighting
- Green BELLE grant of £7,500
- Solar PV is generating energy and LED lighting is reducing electricity demand by 40%




How to Apply for Green BELLE

- Submit an Expression of Interest online <u>www.greenbelle.org.uk</u>
- Full Application form
- Applications are sent to a grant panel







Green BELLE gives grants of up to £10,000 to support SMEs in Leicester and Leicestershire to install low carbon measures and increase their energy efficiency. Green BELLE is part-funded through the European Regional Development Fund (ERDF).
