

Economic Update





- Last qtr growth 0.4%, service driven
- Inflation 3% increasing cost of food & fuel
- Interest rate hike now likely
- Wage rate growth 2.2% squeeze on incomes, retail slowdown
- Low unemployment 0.4% Blaby 265 people 0.7% LLEP 4335 people
- Record high level employment yet some underemployed in part time or lower level jobs
- Brexit uncertainty firms still investing








...of firms in Q3 expect staffing levels to rise in Q4, up from 33% of firms in Q2 looking at Q3











Labour market challenges
